Chair's Report –

Robyn Leary was sworn in as a new Board member. LJSB now has 13 board members and 3 Board openings. John Sheridan has offered to return to the Board and needs a 2/3 vote to be appointed.

Appointments: Last month, Brian Early and Ross Rudolph were appointed to the Traffic and Transportation Committee. This month, the Chair appoints Angie Preisendorfer, Janie Emerson, Myrna Naegle, Ted Haas, and Matt Edwards to the La Jolla Shores Permit Review Committee (LJSPRC) and asks for the Board's verbal consent. The Board consents and these names will now be forwarded to the La Jolla Community Planning Ass'n (LJCPA) to be ratified. In early fall, LJSA will need 3 appointees for the UCSD CAG and one for La Jolla Town Council (LJTC).

Mike Czajkowski asked why his name was not on the re-appointments to the LJSPRC. The Chair explained that the LJSA Chair appoints 5 Shores people to the LJSPRC once a year. The LJSA Board consents and the appointments are sent to LCPA to ratify. The terms start in June and last 1 year.

John Shannon – Reports from La Jolla Parks and Beaches Committee that the Rough Water Swim is now La Jolla Open Water Swim to be on Sept 8th. www.lajollaopenwaterswim.com. They expect 600 participants.

UCSD Representative Report - Anu Delouri:

To see what designs are in the works, visit [www.plandesignbuild.ucsd.edu](http://plandesignbuild.ucsd.edu). New Hall in design phase, 191,000 sf building in the engineering school. Will replace existing parking lot taking away 355 parking spaces. They have 16K parking spaces now. However, all existing parking lots are potential future building spaces! May build parking structures, but they hope to use the Trolley and MRT instead of cars. There are 39K students now, 42K future. Married apartments may be torn down and rebuilt as faculty housing. Will they be tall buildings?

Question: how can La Jolla residents influence the planning for this over growth and impact on our community. A new Living and Learning center at the La Jolla Playhouse Theaters will ruin the accessibility to residents and kill the theater program. We need to hear about projects before they are pre-destined.

Council District 1 - Mauricio Medina:

The city has updated the Scooter regulations - micro mobility. Tried to get prohibition on boardwalks, but attorney said couldn't because no noticing – so can't regulate as hard. Need new ordinance. Also issues regarding where they stage the scooters as they are showing up in front of residences and blocking driveways. Police representative said if scooters are on private property or blocking your driveway, you may move them onto the street.

Vehicle habitation regulation review next week for new ordinance. Budget review committee wrapping up. Our inputs due next month.

Repairing and improving the path south of the Marine Room is proceeding forward

Police are reluctant to go up to cars at night and give out tickets so may use a remote ticketing device. Ticketing will stop the people from parking there after 10pm.
