## **Beach Fires Signage**

Our office had a meeting with Parks and Recreation and the Mayor's Office to discuss the changes in signage we think are imperative for the coastal communities. Parks and Recreation is working with the City Attorney's Office to create a mockup of new signage that will clearly demonstrate all the rules outlined by the Municipal Code.

With that said, we haven't received an update yet on what the signage may look like but have provided the examples that were shared with us to Parks and Recreation. Our policy team is following up with staff to see if they have any new developments since our last meeting.

## **Mental Health Facilities – Agenda Item from Dan Courtney**

A Building and Land Use Enforcement (BLUE) case has been filed for the residence on Torrey Pines Road, CE- 0527330. Through this process, staff will determine if the property is in violation of the Municipal Code.

If there are violations at the property, BLUE staff will issue formal violations and will be responsible for the enforcement of correcting any violations.
